# ADULT DAY SERVICES: ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The eligibility requirements to become an Adult Day Services participant are as follows...

- At least 18 years or older
- Physical disability (neurological or orthopedic impairment) requiring assistance in one or more of their activities of daily living. Limited openings are available to adults 65 years of age or older with one or more chronic health problems and limitations in performing one or more activities of daily living.
- Live in non-institutional setting
- Free of communicable disease
- At risk of institutionalization or further deterioration
- Free of disruptive behavioral issues that would create a danger to self, others or cause a disruption to the programming
- Must have stamina to tolerate at least 3-4 hours away from home and be able and willing to participate in activities. Adaptations are provided.
- Individuals with significant health issues, confusion, or mental illness may be unable to benefit from the services. The program does not accept individuals with an ID/DD.
- Client must be able to stand and pivot for transfers

Common diagnoses of adults who participate in the program include stroke survivors, spinal cord injury, multiple sclerosis, muscular dystrophy, cerebral palsy and other neurological or orthopedic diagnoses.

The memory care program accepts clients with any dementia diagnosis that also fit the above criteria.
