PEDIATRIC THERAPY: ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Turnstone's eligibility criteria as it pertains to pediatric speech, physical, occupational or aquatic therapy is as follows...

For children age birth to 11

- Physical impairment due to orthopedic or neurological medical conditions, OR have significant generalized developmental delays
- Require skilled therapy services from a licensed Physical, Occupational, or Speech Therapist to reach maximum potential
- Potential to participate and benefit from established therapy program
- Requires a physician prescription

Ages 12 to 18 (or until age 21 if enrolled in high school)

- Physical impairment due to orthopedic or neurological medical conditions, OR have significant generalized delays related to neurological conditions
- Has potential to reach established goals by participation in skilled therapy services from a licensed Physical, Occupational, or Speech Therapist
- Requires periodic monitoring services to ensure appropriateness of positioning/seating equipment, braces, and/or home exercise program
- Requires short term skilled therapy services to reach maximum potential in a targeted area (personal care tasks, mobility independence, etc.) or to develop an exercise regime to transition to Fitness membership.
- Requires short term skilled therapy services following a medical exacerbation, procedure or surgical intervention.
