“We are hoping to make this the most inclusive Trunk or Treat in Fort Wayne,” says Chanda Lichtsinn, Director of Rehab Therapy for Turnstone, “this is the perfect environment for families who might have someone that can’t make a long walk around the neighborhood, can’t navigate stairs well or might have communication issues.”
